



Medicaid/CHIP (including Medicaid Expansion) in Montana 2003-2018



Montana's Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) population has changed significantly over the last 15 years. Medicaid expansion, which began in 2016, has increased the total population covered by Medicaid by roughly 100,000 adults. As of 2018 there were more adults covered by Medicaid than children covered by Medicaid/CHIP.



The percentage of Montana's population covered by Medicaid or CHIP has increased significantly over time: from 8.9% in 2003 to 26.1% in 2018. The primary drivers behind this increase are the expansion of the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) in 2009 and the state's adoption of Medicaid expansion in 2016. As of 2018 53.6% of Montana's children were covered under Medicaid or CHIP and 17.8% of adults were covered by Medicaid.
