

State-Owned Space by Agency

According to the most recent data compiled by the Risk Management and Tort Division, the state of Montana owns 4,532 buildings — 23 million square feet of space (including not only buildings but space related to sporting activities, gazebos, picnic structures, outhouses and historic structures.) The Montana University System (MUS) owns the most space with 14.2 million square feet, or 62% of the total state-owned space. MUS-owned space primarily consists of classrooms and student housing.

The Department of Transportation (MDT) owns the greatest amount of space aside from MUS with 2.1 million square feet. The MDT space consists in large part of airport hangars and equipment garages.
