


Tobacco Settlement Distribution

FY 2018 = \$25.3 (millions)



This pie chart shows the distribution of annual tobacco settlement payments to Montana. The state constitution requires not less than 40% of tobacco settlement money be dedicated to a permanent tobacco trust fund. The remaining revenue is distributed between the general fund (11%), the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) state special revenue fund (17%), and the Tobacco Prevention state special revenue fund (32%). Allowable uses of the 32% Tobacco Prevention distribution include tobacco prevention/cessation programs and chronic disease programs. Money not appropriated within two years is transferred to the tobacco trust fund.
