


The state of Montana receives federal funding to provide government services like **public health**, **transportation**, **infrastructure**, **development**, and **general uses**.



According to the U.S. Census Bureau, federal grants have made up 38-46% of Montana state government revenues from FY 2002 to FY 2017. This chart illustrates the service sectors where these revenues are used by the state government. Note that the public health category includes federal grants for Medicaid expansion that began in 2016.
