


## Chart of the Week | Property Taxes

Growth in **property taxes collected** since TY 2001 is a combination of growth in property taxes paid to local governments (**counties, cities & towns, special district levies, and special districts fees**) and to public schools\* (**state property taxes, county-wide school levies, and school districts**). School districts account for the largest portion of property taxes collected, and they accounted for a large portion of the increase from between TY 2016 and TY 2019. Fire & other accounted for the smallest portion of the increase, but had the largest compound annual growth rate **since TY 2001** at 7.067%. State property taxes had the smallest growth rate **since TY 2001** at 3.170%.
