

**DOC:** In advance of the September 14th IBC meeting, the committee is asking DOC to help give us a better understanding through written materials of:

- (1) the internal programs of the prisons focused on rehabilitation;
- (2) reentry programs;
- (3) the purpose and importance of IPPOs;
- (4) the effectiveness of the reevaluation of CDITU and the ability of inmates to get placed in programs to fulfill their treatment requirements; and
- (5) the process of the negotiations for the Core Civic contract and the opportunity to put in place a comprehensive contract or barriers to doing so.

**Core Civic:** In advance of the September 14th IBC meeting, the committee is asking Core Civic to help give us a better understanding about its current contract with the State through written materials of:

- (1) an overview of the fines imposed by DOC;
- (2) the programs offered focused on rehabilitation and the level of staffing dedicated to these programs;
- (3) the additional costs/staffing if Core Civic were to offer expanded programs focused on rehabilitation and reentry classes, a discussion of those potential offerings, and barriers to implementing any such changes;
- (4) an overview of the contract and the process the State and Core Civic would need to get a comprehensive contract in place; and
- (5) a discussion of rehabilitation and reentry programs utilized by Core Civic in other jurisdictions.
