The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) was signed into law by President Biden on November 15, 2021. The law authorizes \$1.2 trillion for transportation and infrastructure spending with \$550 billion of that designated for “new” investments and programs.

The State of Montana will receive funding from IIJA for various purposes across multiple state agencies. Some of the funding is formula-based where state agencies are assured to receive funding, while other is based on competitive grant applications.

Since the legislature was not in session to consider the additional funding, the executive is authorized by 17-7-part 4, MCA, to appropriate the funds via budget amendments. However, given the significant level of funding and known legislative interest, the executive plans to partner with lawmakers via the Legislative Finance Committee to elicit input and involvement while assuring transparency between branches regarding the appropriation and expenditure of IIJA funds.

In contrast to the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CARES Act) or the State Fiscal Recovery Fund (ARPA), there are no flexible or discretionary pots of funding available to the state within IIJA. All funding sources available to state agencies are considered “siloed” and must be used for specific purposes as designated by federal requirements. It should be noted that much of the guidance related to program requirements is not yet available.

The executive plans to regularly update the Legislative Finance Committee and receive comments and recommendations regarding IIJA at each of its quarterly meetings. As information and guidance is received from the federal government regarding amounts, timing and constraints, these will be also be shared to the LFC during regular updates.

Attached is an up-to-date snapshot of the various funding sources available through IIJA and what funding will or may (through competitive grant applications) be received by the State of Montana. The Office of Budget and Program Planning (OBPP), in cooperation with applicable state agencies, will continue to keep this document updated as additional information becomes available.

OBPP plans to code IIJA funds in the state accounting system, similar to codes used for CARES Act, ARPA, and other recently received federal COVID and stimulus funding. This will allow for easy tracking, reporting, and transparency.
