
# **BOARD OF PUBLIC EDUCATION**

# **HB2** BUDGET MODIFICATIONS

The following chart shows the HB 2 budget as passed by the legislature, including the pay plan, and the HB 2 modified budget from July 1, 2023, through November 30, 2023. Net modifications to the budget include operating plan changes from one expenditure account to another, program transfers, reorganizations, and agency transfers of authority. The positive modifications and negative modifications are shown by program, expenditure account, and fund type.





The Board of Public Education has expended their FY 2024 budget by 27.5%, slightly below the historic average of 33.2%. During the 2023 Legislative Session, the Board of Public Education received authority for HB 549 in HB 2 but did not receive the requested 2.00 FTE. A limited solicitation to support the work within HB 549 was posted, but the Board of Public Education did not receive applications sufficient to their request. Funding received from HB 549 has been minimally spent in operating costs, though a majority of the work has been related to personal services.


Due to HB 403, the Board of Public Education is now fully funded by general fund. HB 13 provided the Board of Public Education state special revenue within the pay plan, but they no longer have spending authority for state special revenue. The Board of Public Education has worked with the Office of Budget and Program Planning to utilize a personal services contingency if the current budget is unable to support the implementation of the pay plan.

## **Personal Services**

Appropriations for personal services in the Board of Public Education total approximately \$265,000 and are 37.5% expended through November 30, 2023. The Board of Public Education did not utilize contracted labor and has not paid any overtime during the first quarter. The department has 3.00 HB 2 FTE and 100.0% of these positions are filled as of November 1, 2023. The following chart shows the filled and vacant FTE within the agency as of November 1, 2023.



The chart below shows the hourly utilization percentage for the Board of Public Education between July 1 and November 1 for each fiscal year. With all FTE positions filled, the utilization is currently under 100.0% due to one position working on a part-time status of 20 hours/week. Overall, the department has utilized approximately 84.8% of the hours budgeted for FY 2024, as shown in the chart below.
