RESPONSE TO INTERIM COMMITTEE REQUESTS

FOR: Interim Budget Committee, Section B (Health and Human Services)

REQUESTED INFORMATION: The Department received multiple requests related to Medicaid disenrollment including:

- How many children are included in the approx. 55k (to-date) who have lost coverage?
- What is the disenrollment by county for children?
- How many new applications are the result of citizens who have been disenrolled?
- What is the disenrollment by age, sex, American Indian/Alaskan Native?

RESPONSE: The information provided below includes disenrollment between April 2023 and August 2023. This data was pulled on August 25th. This is point in time data that will change each time it is pulled as the status of individuals change.

- Of the approx. 55,000 people who lost coverage, 24,150 are children between 0 and 18 years. Child disenrollment by county is as follows:
