RESPONSE TO INTERIM COMMITTEE REQUESTS

FOR: Interim Budget Committee, Section B (Health and Human Services)

REQUESTED INFORMATION: Senator Pope requested a report on the progress of claim adjustments to reflect the new Medicaid rates for claims already paid with a date of service since July 1, 2023.

RESPONSE: All Medicaid rates were updated in the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) in September with a July 1 effective date. Going forward all claims will be paid based on the new rates. The Department will systematically adjust most claims already paid with a date of service since July 1 to reflect the new rates. Due to limitation on the number of adjustments the MMIS can handle at a time, the process is expected to take a few months. The Department will provide an update on progress monthly. Systematic adjustments began the week of September 18th. A small set of providers will need to manually re-bill to receive the higher rates and are not reflected in the numbers below.

*Total claims to be systematically adjusted will decrease over time, as providers submit their own adjustment to the original claim for a variety of reasons.
