Below is one case DCI was asked to lead and/or participate in an investigation in the current fiscal year, but due to resource constraints was declined:

7/24: Trespass/Disorderly Conduct

**Madison County** 

Reason declined: A series of multiple cases involving homicide, officer-involved shootings, in-custody jail deaths, sexual assaults and complex theft cases absorbed Major Case resources in the months of June and July.

The number of investigations by DCI that were referred to federal prosecutors that resulted in charges being filed in federal court, the names of the defendants, and the crimes charged are as follows:

SSI/CDU had the following three (3) cases (fourth quarter to present4):

- US v. Terry Smith 42 USC 408(a)(4) (Failure to Report Event Affecting Eligibility to Benefits), 18 USC 641, (Theft), 18 USC 1343 (Wire Fraud), 18 USC 1001 (False Statement)
- US v. Gerry Albus 18 USC 1383(a)(3), (Concealment of Event Affecting Continued Eligibility to Benefits), 18 USC 641, (Theft)
- U.S. v. Cedric Neal 42 USC 408(a)(3), (False Statement of Material Fact in Determining Rights to Benefits), 18 USC 1001, (False Statement)

Medicaid Fraud Control Unit, OCP, Elder Justice, Fire Marshal and Organized Retail Crime have had no cases referred federally.
