-What is working

- -Currently offer tutoring on campus Monday-Thursday 930-230
- -Built partnerships with various community programs that work with community members who need services such as courts, social services, 477 adult programs, and tribal education department.
 - -Offer study material to those who wish to study from home or unable to come to office
 - -Offer practice tests
 - -Offer financial assistance to pay for testing for those who are unable to

-What isn't working

-Limited fund available so we currently can only offer one tutor which is located in the Poplar office when prior we had a tutor located on both Poplar and Wolf Point campus.

-Currently we've seen about 3 students take some form of college classes currently after obtaining their HiSet, most wish to obtain theirs to work.

3. Are students reporting why they are pursuing the HiSET? Is it workforce access or further education.

-Obtaining a job is the main reason that they are pursuing their HiSet.
