"Operations and maintenance" means operational costs and regular, ongoing, and routine 11 (9) 12 repairs and maintenance funded in an agency operating budget that does not extend the capacity, function, or 13 lifespan of a facility. 14 (10)"Replacement cost of existing long-range building program-eligible building" means the current replacement value of all long-range building program-eligible buildings included in the statewide facility 15 16 inventory and condition assessment as provided in 17-7-202." 17 18 NEW SECTION. Section 13. Project management and supervision. Up to \$2,000,000 is 19 appropriated from the major repair long-range building program account to the architecture and engineering 20 division for the purposes of contracted services or modified positions, and associated operating expenses, to 21 expeditiously implement [sections 1 through 9]. The division is authorized to transfer the appropriation among 22 the necessary fund types for supervision and project management. 23 24 NEW SECTION. Section 14. Severability. If a part of [this act] is invalid, all valid parts that are 25 severable from the invalid part remain in effect. If a part of [this act] is invalid in one or more of its applications, 26 the part remains in effect in all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications. 27
