

## State Capitol Building Improvements amendment

Page 13, line 28

Strike: \$26,316,458

Insert: \$28,695,418

This increases the capitol building improvements project to include:

- Completing the House Chamber floor repairs and carpet replacement project
  - To repair significant subfloor deficiencies, and associated relocation of electrical and network cabling
- Repairs and improvements to the House, Senate, and Old Supreme Court galleries
  - Including removal of gallery chairs, and ADA and safety improvements
- Repairs to Chamber desks
- Third floor office carpeting replacement
- Upgrade of first floor audit division cubicles in conjunction with the carpet replacement authorized last session
- And associated moving, storage, and relocation costs

These deficiencies were identified during the design and implementation of the Legislative Chamber Carpet and Legislative Staff Workplace Improvements projects appropriated by the 2021 Session and are recommended to be addressed through these additional funds which will augment those existing projects.
