21	university fund	ds.
22	(2)	"Capital development" means capital projects provided for in 17-7-201(2).
23	(3)	"Capital project" means the planning, design, renovation, construction, alteration, replacement
24	furnishing, rep	pair, improvement, site, utility, or land acquisition project provided for in [sections 1 through 10].
25	(4)	"LRBP capital development" means the long-range building program capital developments
26	account in the	capital projects fund type provided for in 17-7-209.
27	(5)	"LRBP major repair" or "LRBP MR" means the long-range building program major repair
28	account in the	capital projects fund type provided for in 17-7-221.



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1	(6)	"Major repair'	means capita	I projects	provided for in	17-7-201(7).
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- 2 (7) "Other funding sources" means money other than LRBP money, state special revenue, or 3 federal special revenue that accrues to an agency under the provisions of law.
- 4 (8) "SBECP" means funds from the state building energy conservation program account in the capital projects fund type, which may be utilized on either or both major repair and capital development projects.

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NEW SECTION. Section 2. Major repair projects appropriations and authorizations. (1) The following money is appropriated to the department of administration for the indicated major repair projects from the indicated sources. Funds not requiring legislative appropriation are included for the purpose of authorization. The department of administration is authorized to adjust capital project amounts within the legislative intent of the major repair account-funded projects, subject to available revenues, if approved by the office of budget and program planning, and transfer the appropriations, authority, or both among the necessary fund types for these projects:
