- Certified

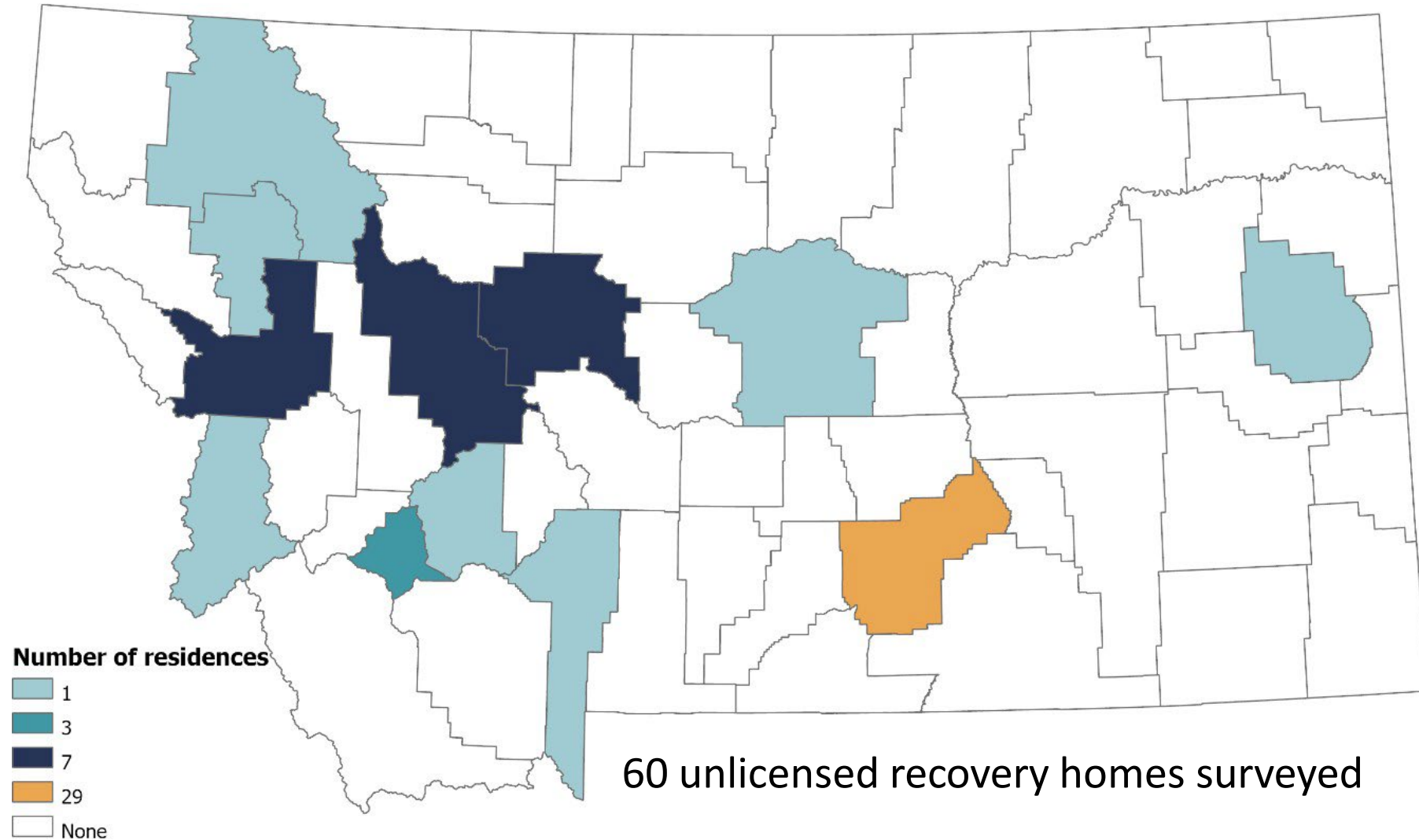




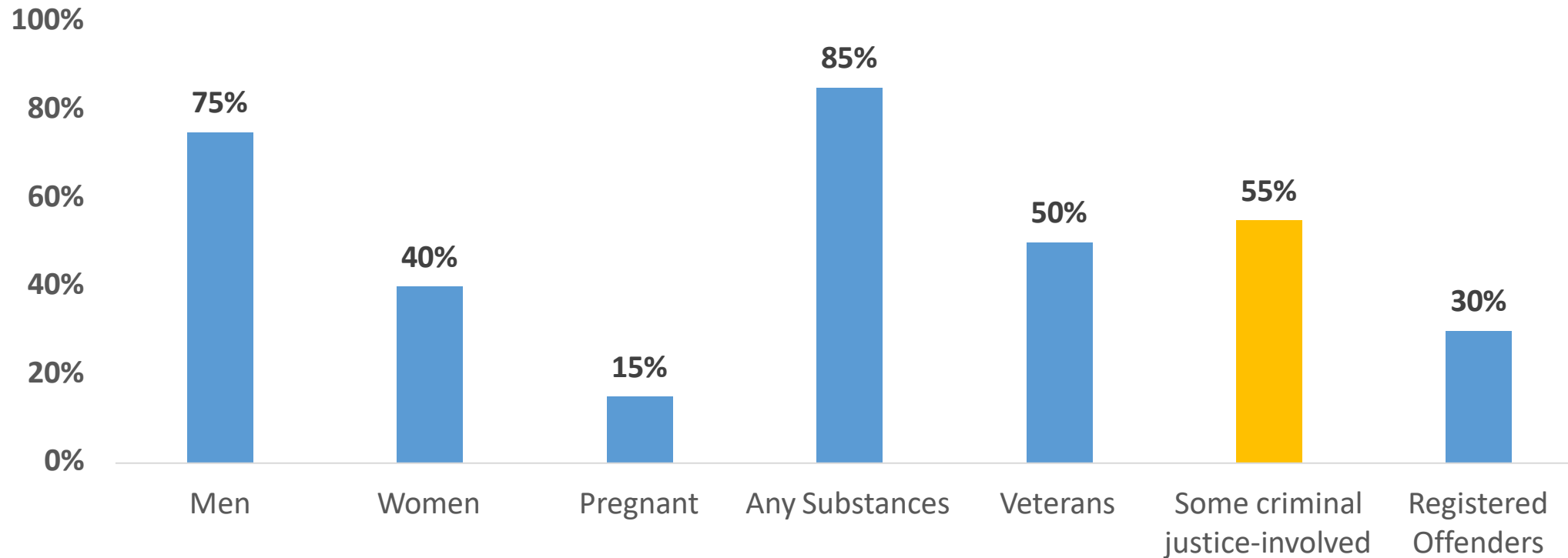

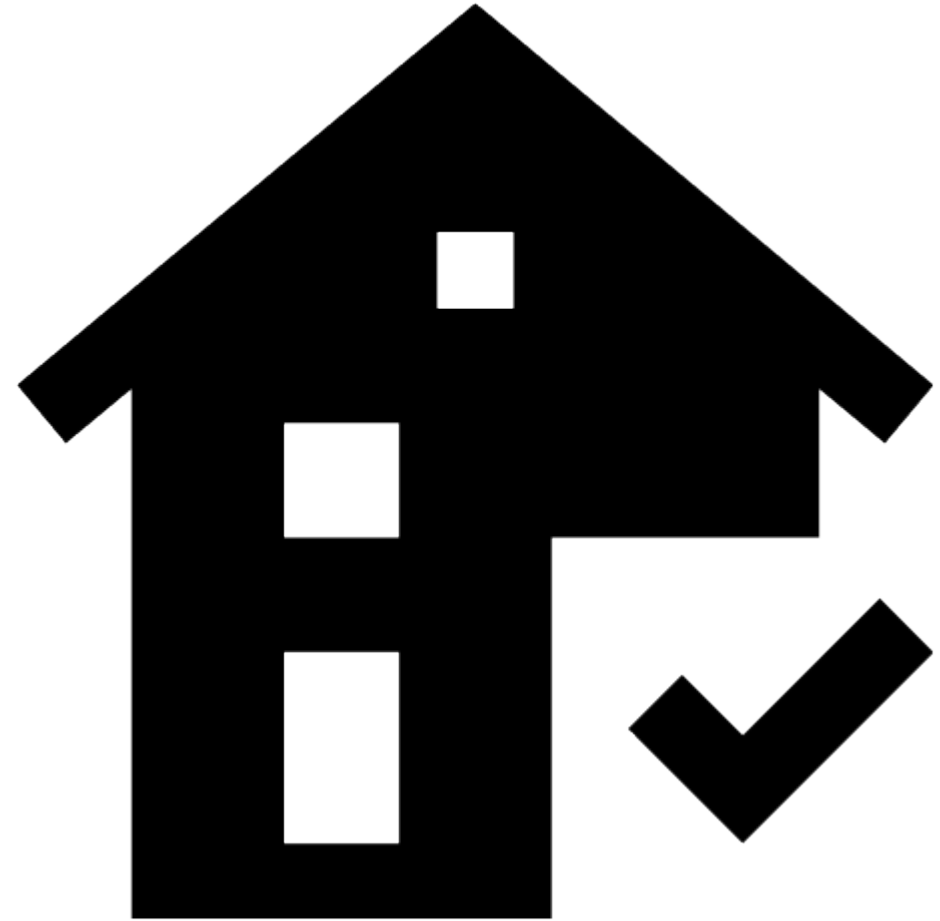
