

- River Road East Fire (2023)
  - "Unknown" cause
  - 27 sq. miles burned
  - \$16.1 million firefighting costs
  - 711 crew members (at peak)
  - 64 structures destroyed
  - 4<sup>th</sup>-most destructive since 2006










Health effect air quality categories at Montana monitoring sites (PM2.5 concentration) 2019 vs. 2021 (Department of Environmental Quality)








