This project funding will be used to improve the operation of the non-potable water system and eliminate the need for additional water supply from the City of Helena for irrigation purposes. Another part of the funding will be to provide a backup source of potable water that will provide resiliency in water supply to major facilities at Fort Harrison during emergency situations.
