Explanation - This amendment reduces the appropriation for HB 7 due to the overappropriation of the natural resources projects account -- to balance appropriations with anticipated revenues. The appropriation could support the first six projects on the RDGP list.

The second amendment removes the language that requires that projects are funded in priority order and allows all projects listed in subsection (4) to obtain funding as they meet the grant conditions.
